RESOLVED to note Cllr C Beaumont welcomed everyone to the meeting.

RESOLVED to note the following:
- The Clerk to set up a meeting with Harworth Estates, Tony Morris and the Parish Council.
 - C Beaumont, A Harper and the Clerk to meet to discuss the security for the Rossington Festival and the drinks order with the Imperial Micro Brewery.
 - The Clerk to contact Howarth Estates, Harron Homes and Rossington Hall re sponsorship and/or support with Herras Fencing for the day.
 - The Clerk to contact the Police to invite them to bring along Police Horses and/or Police Dogs.
 - The Clerk to chase up the TA.
 - The Clerk to contact local Army Cadets
 - John Gibson to investigate Rossington Main Juniors running a 5-a-side football tournament.

- 403. TO DISCUSS THE CHRISTMAS LIGHTS FOR 2016**
RESOLVED to note the following:
- The decision to continue using Christmasist for Christmas lights was proposed by J Parkin, seconded by J Rowland-Johnson.
 - According to Highways, all the lampposts that had a socket fitted and have had LED lights fitted will retain a socket

- J R-J to check if there are any plans for trees to be trimmed
- The 3 trees to the right of St Michael's Church to be draped with Christmas lights
- The large tree outside the Holmescarr Centre to be wrapped with potentially 12 spheres
- The middle tree on Pheasant Bank to potentially have 12 spheres.
- The four lampposts on Radburn Road have sockets fitted ready for ornaments
- The Clerk to visit the Styrrup Pub on Station Road to clarify ownership of the first large tree near the village pump.
- The Clerk to inform Jim Blaik of all the lampposts that need a socket fitting.
- The Clerk to write to Attero re sponsorship of a tree on the small roundabout from the link road.
- A quote for a substantial Christmas tree to be planted on the Circle and on the small roundabout from the link road.
- The Clerk to write to Harworth Estates re installing box hedging with 'Welcome to Rossington' that can be lit up with Christmas lights.
- The Clerk to write to Tony Morris as to the whereabouts of the miner's wheel.
- The Clerk to write to the Golf Course re contribution to the Christmas tree lights on Stripe Road.
- The contract for the ornaments (which are rented) on the lampposts has ended so new ornaments can now be chosen and installed.
- It was suggested only half the ornament be installed on current lampposts freeing up ornaments for Radburn Road.
- If the quote is under budget investigate Christmas lights being installed on Stripe Road and West End Lane.
- Z Attridge to put a request on Facebook for ideas for more Christmas lights and ornaments to discuss for 2017.
