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MINUTES OF THE PROJECTS COMMITTEE OF ROSSINGTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ROSSINGTON MEMORIAL HALL AT 6.15 PM ON TUESDAY 3 JANUARY 2016

337. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

RESOLVED to note the Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and wished everyone a Happy New Year.

338. PUBLIC FORUM

RESOLVED to note there were no members of the public present.

339. DAVE WYNN, DMBC TEAM LEADER TREES, WOODLANDS AND COUNTRYSIDE

DMBC are looking to improve the look of Rossington by clearing damaged trees and planting new trees. They would like input from the Council on where trees could be planted and the type of tree to plant.

RESOLVED to note the following:

- Initial suggestions hedgerows at the cemetery, screening for the new sub-station, a substantial Christmas tree at the 2 main focal entry points – Sheep Bridge Lane and Stripe Road, tree planting on Stripe Road.
- Residents of the Circle to be consulted re planting of new trees in a more formal fashion.
- Whips can be sought for free from the National Trust but more substantial trees can cost around £250 to £300.
- Terry Chandler from the Environment Association to be invited to the next Projects Committee Meeting on Tuesday 2 February 2016.
- Suggested costs for new trees be shared between DMBC, RPC and external funding.
- DMBC to source external funding for trees for Rossington.
- The Parish Council to have a walk around Rossington with DMBC and Environment Association for further suggestions for tree planting and types of trees plus planting of hedgerows.
- Whips could be grown on at volunteers' allotments
- A mixture of trees to be identified.
- The planting of wild flower seeds in bedding areas for a more maintenance free display was suggested.
