### 4587. TO RECEIVE BUSINESSES FROM BANKWOOD LANE INDUSTRIAL ESTATE

**RESOLVED** to note the following:

- Morris & Co Ltd have installed new speed limit signage and informed Haulage Companies.
- If Hauliers are not complying, registration numbers and times to be sent to Zoe Piggott.

- Attero Recycling Ltd are working with Network Rail and Db Schenker to transport waste on the Network Railway track they've acquired use of it as it is on Attero land. Attero feel it makes sense environmentally as it will reduce their carbon footprint.

**4588. TO RECEIVE NEIL FIRTH REPRESENTING OVERLAPPING THEMES OF TRANSPORTATION AND HIGHWAYS**

- Concerns were raised about ongoing issues with one of the businesses on Bankwood Lane.
