172. TO DISCUSS WITH HELEN METCALF THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN FOR ROSSINGTON VILLAGE

- Helen presented a list of the Neighbourhood Plans she has completed/working on with other Parish and Town Council.
- Helen has spoken to Jayne Stimpson (Planning Environment Manager, Built and Natural Environment Team, Planning Development Regeneration and Environment).
- Helen explained the Neighbourhood Plan is a Statutory Planning Document
- The Clerk to apply to Locality for a grant of £9,000. Helen advised to print off the template prior to applying online.
- There may be a further £6,000 the Parish can apply for in the future.
- The Parish needs to work closely with the Doncaster MBC 2012 Core Strategy and the new development plan that is currently being developed.

- Houses that have outline planning permission could be influenced by the completed Neighbourhood Plan once it has been accepted.
- An option may to bring in an Urban Designed to look at for example Rossington Town Centre that could be included in the Neighbourhood Plan.
- Boundary treatments such as landscaping and greenery on roads and paths could be included in the Neighbourhood Plan.
- Types of shops needed rather than more eg fast food outlets, hairdressers, beauty parlours, etc could be included.
- Higher quality employment such as trade and apprenticeships could be included.
- Everything that goes in the Neighbourhood Plan **has** to be evidenced.
- When the draft plan is submitted to Doncaster MBC the Parish will be given 3 examiners to choose from.
