MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT ROSSINGTON MEMORIAL HALL AT 7.00 pm on TUESDAY 08 NOVEMBER 2016

4676. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

Cllr B Johnson opened the meeting and welcomed Cllrs, Ward Cllrs and the public to the meeting.

4677. PUBLIC SESSION

RESOLVED to note the following:

- Three members of St Michael's School PTA explained how they were fundraising with a Bingo Night where half the proceeds would go to Children in Need and half to purchasing a Defibrillator as one of the parent's husband who has an unexpected congenital heart condition only survived due to a defibrillator being used. Her three children – one of which goes to St Michael's School – have a 50:50 chance of having the same condition. She explained that survival rates go up from 8% to 75% if a Defibrillator is available. St Michael's School is funding the installation of the external heated box with the PTA fundraising for the ongoing maintenance. If the box is vandalised, St Michael's School would fund the repairs.
- J Parkin proposed the Parish would fund the short fall to purchase the Defibrillator, seconded by C Beaumont and agreed by all the Cllrs present.
- Barry Johnson will be retiring from the role of Chair of the parish Council in May 2017.

4678. ANNOUNCEMENTS

RESOLVED to note the following:

- J Cooke informed the meeting that Gattison House and Plantation View Homes were to be demolished with a new home being built on Goodison Boulevard in Cantley. This would enable Tordedale Field to be opened up for development. He wanted to encourage residents to carry on using Gattison House as if they did they would automatically go to the new home.
- Blood Doner sessions to be held at the Miners Welfare.

- A Media statement was circulated from the South Yorkshire Police and Crime Commission announcing that Sioned-Mair Richards successfully interviewed for the role of Assistant Police and Crime Commissioner.

- J Gibson to find out why there was an increase in un-named lorries going along Stripe Road and Sheep Bridge Lane.
- J Cooke and C Stone undertook a 3-day observation evidencing the large number of articulated lorries were coming in and out of Rossington. The results to be presented to Doncaster MBC Planning Department.

- The Parish would like to see evidence of match funding for all the programmes of activity.
- A RAP meeting is to take place at **6.15 on Tuesday 31 January 2017** so the partnership can present their programme of activities to the Parish Council.

4690. TO DISCUSS TRAFFIC CALMING MATRIX SIGN

RESOLVED to note the following:

- Andrew Smith from Inserter Sales and Services on Bankwood Lane has offered to cover 50% of the £750.00 cost of a mobile traffic matrix which can be sited at different areas in Rossington.
 - Residents to contact the Parish Council with areas they feel would benefit from the matrix which will be run past the Police and Highways.
 - A Smith to service, calibrate, store, maintain, place the matrix, top up the diesel for the generator, purchase a wheel clamp and a chain to secure matrix.
 - A Smith to run the generator to check the noise levels.
 - The Parish Council to investigate insuring the matrix.
 - J Cooke explained there are only a few areas the matrix can be sited. If on private land permissions would need to be sought. The matrix is not enforceable but a deterrent.
- C Beaumont proposed the Parish support the matrix project, seconded by J Cooke.
