**6.2** The effect of the proposed Order will be to:-

(i) amend the existing length of the 50 MPH speed limit contained in Schedule 4.01 of the Order:

(a) That length of the Great North Road at Rossington which extends from 38 metres south of its junction with Plumpton Park Road in a southerly direction to 485 metres north west of its junction with Littleworth Lane

will be substituted with the following item:

That length of the Great North Road at Rossington which extends from 38 metres south of its junction with Plumpton Park Road in a southerly direction to its junction with the A6182 Great Yorkshire Way

(b) That length of the A6182 which extends from its junction with the A638 Bawtry Road to a point 200 metres from the north-western kerb line of B6463 Sheep Bridge Lane

will be substituted with the following item:

That length of the A6182 Great Yorkshire Way from a point 200 metres from the north-western kerb line of B6463 Sheep Bridge Lane to a point 130 metres from the south-western kerb line of Hurst Lane

(ii) include the following item in Schedule 4.01 of the Order:

That length of the Great North Road at Rossington A638 which extends from its junction with the A6182 Great Yorkshire Way to a point 200 metres in a south easterly direction

(iii) amend the existing length of the 40 MPH speed limit contained in Schedule 3.01 of the Order:

That length of Hurst Lane at Auckley which extends from a point 41 metres south west of the southern kerblines of Hayfield Lane (west) in a south westerly direction to a point 39 metres south west of the southern kerblines of Larch Avenue

will be substituted with the following item:

That length of Hurst Lane at Auckley which extends from a point 41 metres south west of the southern kerblines of Hayfield Lane (west) in a south westerly direction to a point 60 metres from its junction with the southern kerb line of A6182 Great Yorkshire Way

(iv) remove the following item from Schedule 3.01 of the Order:

That length of the A6182 Great Yorkshire Way from a point 130 metres from the south-western kerb line of Hurst Lane to its junction with Hurst Lane
