James Russell offered the following:

- Community First Yorkshire can offer advice and support on Governance and Structure issues and Policies and Procedures.
- They can also offer model documents and templates.
- The first stage needs to be the Community Consultation which needs to involve not only the community but as many potential partners and stakeholders as possible.
- The consultation needs to also engage with any potential future volunteers who may be interested in taking on an active role such as on the Management Committee.
- The Clerk to apply to Locality for a grant to undertake a Community Consultation, Feasibility Study and Business Plan for the Youth Club Building. This would be necessary for future requirements such as applying for external grant funding.
- The Clerk to contact funding specialists to find out what is the best structure for managing the youth club building and any future potential youth/services.

- There are a number of structures that could take place but it may be best to investigate a Charitable Incorporate Organisation so the new organisation would only need to register with the Charity Commission and there would be no risk to Trustees or Management Committee.
- James will talk to the Plunkett Foundation on what they feel would be the best structure.
- The Clerk to register with the Plunkett Foundation.
