709. TO CONSIDER THE PLANTING OF THE FLOWER BEDS IN ROSSINGTON WITH MARK WINWOOD FROM AWS LANDSCAPES

RESOLVED to note the following:

709.1 Quote for Summer Planting

The quote supplied by AWS Landscapes, whilst still current, contained elements that were no longer relevant so Mark Winwood to revise accordingly. He felt the work needed to start immediately to be ready for Summer 2018.

- The Clerk to advise Mark as soon as possible on the amount left in the budget for 2017/2018 so he can start planning the layout of the beds, ordering plants and tailoring the planting accordingly.

- The Cllrs present proposed a budget of up to £10,000 on the plants and planting, preparation, weeding and so on with money left in the budget for watering.

709.2 Railing Planters

Mark explained the railing planters were no longer available and to purchase some would be very expensive. The Parish Council ratified not do railing planting this year.

709.3 Flower Beds

The Parish Council to focus on the flower beds for Summer 2018 which will be planted with perennials and annuals in the Spring of 2018.

- Mark to remove the wooden edging from the bed on Grange Lane as it is now rotten.

709.4 Tiered Planters

Mark suggested that for 2018 the tiered planters be reduced to just one planter height then planted with ivies plus a central perennial. It was felt that to remove the planters all together would give the impression to residents that they had been forgotten.

- J Parkin suggested the planters on Ashville be relocated to Station Road. Mark confirmed his staff would move them.
- The Clerk to seek permission from Doncaster Council.
