He proposed that Rebecca retain the building for the period of one year to give the Parish Council time to sort the lease and get an amicable agreement with Doncaster Council.

Over the last year the Parish Council has held a number of meetings, employed Ann Hindley to produce a Business Plan, a Feasibility Study and undertake Consultation, employed Grice & Hunter to undertake a Condition Survey of the building and met with Katy Foster from Reaching Communities. The Parish Council however, feel they are no further ahead with 1) the lease and 2) with any feedback from the Condition Survey and what improvements Doncaster Council are able to make to the Youth Club Building.

C Wileman proposed that if things do not move forward, the Parish Council is going to withdraw any involvement in the Youth Club Building. This was seconded by J Cooke and agreed by all Cllrs present at this meeting.
