- Discussion around the development of Cycle Paths around Rossington connecting all current pathways and making the track suitable for all. Developing a Trim Trail around the area to encourage fitness etc. Developing the lakes to enable activities such as water sports, fishing, sailing etc.
- Yorkshire Wildlife Trust have set conditions that the lakes must be for wildlife and ecological benefits, definitely not for commercial usage therefore developing the lakes is not an option.
- Duncan Armstrong-Payne suggested an app that creates QR codes that can map different routes around the Country Park for runners/walkers.
- Possibility of applying for Grants to develop a Trim Trail.
- Peter Peeters discussed Verdion's desire to develop a cycle path from the Vulcan roundabout up to Miller & Carter, he asked that RPC put a letter into DMBC supporting the cycle path plan

- Discussion around litter at the temporary bus stops near the new housing estate, The iPort has its own bus stops but buses are not regular therefore workers are using the temporary stops, these stops don't have bins or shelters and rubbish is piling up.
