5256. TO CONSIDER YOUTH SERVICE PROVISION IN ROSSINGTON

Debbie and Rebecca explained the following:

- Doncaster Council's Asset Department will not do any work to the Youth Club building until the lease has been confirmed.
- They will only bring the building up to Health and Safety standards.

- Debbie and Rebecca have offered to broker the situation for the Parish Council so will be the first point of contact between all parties.
- Doncaster Council has to provide a youth service in Rossington but not necessarily in the Youth Club building.
- There has been interest in renting space at the Youth Club building by EPIC and a group currently using the Holmescarr Centre.

C Wileman explained that the Parish Council has ratified that a second Condition Survey would be undertaken after Doncaster Council had brought the building to H&S standards, prior to the Council agreeing the lease.

J Cooke put forward the suggested that the Parish Council fund a specific item such as wages for Youth Workers. This would enable the Council to allocate the amount in the Parish Budget.
